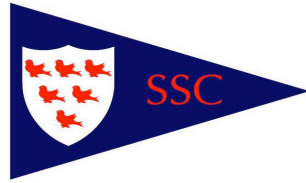

## NOTICE OF RACE

### N12 Shoreham Gul Series #3

**UK Wayfarer Class Southern Area Championships and Craftinsure National Circuit and Travellers' Series Event 4**

**15<sup>th</sup>-16<sup>th</sup> May 2019**

**Organising Authority:**

**Shoreham Sailing Club (SSC) in association with National 12 Association and UK Wayfarer Association**

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 Racing will be governed by the rules as defined in the current ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), RYA prescriptions and the relevant Class rules.
- 1.2 In the case of conflict between the Notice of Race (NoR) and the sailing instructions (SI's), the sailing instructions shall prevail. This changes rule 63.7.
- 1.3 Competitors will wear personal flotation devices while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be used: this changes Rule 40. Wetsuits or dry-suits are not personal floatation devices.
- 1.4 Any changes to the RRS will be given in the SI's.
- 1.5 National 12 Gul Series NoR applies in addition to this NoR

### 2 ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the National 12 Class and of the Wayfarer Class which have a current measurement certificate.
- 2.2 Boats competing for UKWA prizes must be entered by members or associate members of the UKWA or any equivalent National Class Wayfarer Association affiliated to the Wayfarer International Committee (NCWA).
- 2.3 Entries will be accepted from non-members of the UKWA or other NCWA provided they are members of SSC but they will not be eligible for UKWA prizes.
- 2.4 A boat wishing to substitute a helm or a crew after registration shall make prior written request to the race committee to do so. The decision to permit or deny such request shall be entirely at the discretion of the race committee.

### 3 ENTRIES AND FEES

- 3.1 Entries shall be made on the official Entry Form available at reception
- 3.2 Entry fees are £35.00 per boat for the complete event (two days) or £20.00 for one day. These fees include the UKWA and National 12 levies.

3.3 Entries will be accepted up to 12.00 on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June or up to 09.30 on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June for entries on that day only.

## 4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Registration will take place in the club house on Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June between 10.00 and 12.00 and on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June between 08.30 and 09.30.

4.2 The event comprises of a six (6) race series: 3 races on Saturday and 3 races on Sunday.

4.3 At its' discretion the race committee may change the number of races each day but may not start more than 4 races on either day.

4.4 The scheduled time for race briefings will be: Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June not before 11.30; Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June not before 09.00.

4.5 The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the races will be: Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June not before 13.25; Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June not before 10.25.

4.6 No warning signal will be made after 15.00 on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June.

4.7 High water times: Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> June 10.42 (5.8m); Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> June 11.30 (5.9m).

## 5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Sailing instructions will be published on the event website on or before 14<sup>th</sup> June 2019 ([www.shorehamsailing.org](http://www.shorehamsailing.org)) and printed copies will be available at registration.

## 6 VENUE

6.1 Shoreham Sailing Club, Soldiers Point, 223 Harbour Way, Shoreham-by-Sea, West Sussex, BN43 5HZ.

6.2 Racing will normally take place to the West of the harbour entrance.

## 7 PENTALTY SYSTEM

7.1 RRS Rule 44 will apply.

## 8 SCORING

8.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series

8.2 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

8.3 When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 9 PRIZES

9.1 The following prizes will be awarded by the National 12 Association;

- Prizes provided by Gul

9.2 The following prizes will be awarded by the UKWA;

- Bamboozle Trophy - awarded to the winner of the 1<sup>st</sup> race
- Shoreham Ripple - awarded to the winner of the 3<sup>rd</sup> race
- Emsworth Knot - awarded to the first placed boat overall

## 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

10.1 Rule 4 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'the responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone'.

10.2 By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- the provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- the provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- it is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules or information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held at the venue;
- their boat is adequately insured, with cover of at least £2,000,000 or the equivalent per event against third party claims.

## 11 RIGHTS AND COPYRIGHT

11.1 By participating in this event, competitors automatically grant to the organising authority and the event sponsors the right, in perpetuity, to make, use and show, at their discretion, any photography, audio and video recordings and other reproductions of them made at the venue or on the water from the time of their arrival at the venue, until their final departure, without compensation.

## 12 DATA PROTECTION

12.1 In order to manage the event, information provided by competitors will be held on a database. The management of personal information and images will comply with the General Data Protection Regulation.
